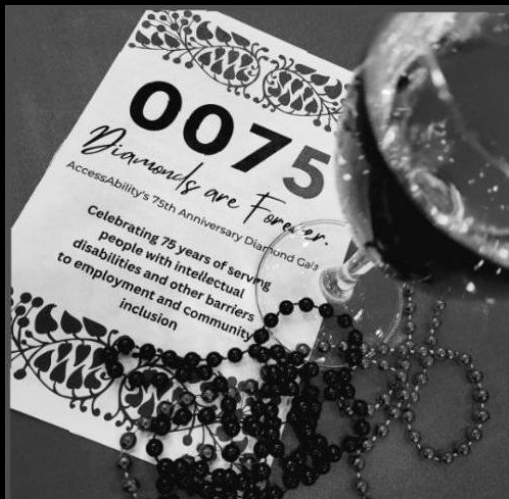

Devon was hired by Prospect Foundry in mid-January as a Forklift Operator before quickly being promoted to Laboratory Technician. Earning this position has been an achievement that comes with a whole new set of responsibilities. It is a learning experience that he has undertaken with great gusto! He is responsible for the testing and tracking of iron and chemicals used in their processing and pours. It is a very technical job with documentation and reporting requirements, but Devon has undertaken them with a commitment to quality, both for the company and for himself personally.

Devon has been so proud of his accomplishments and enjoys sending updates.

Ebony, Project Connect's Adult Basic Education Coordinator, shared that he sent an update just last week, saying, "They like my energy and my work ethic. They want me to prosper with the company."

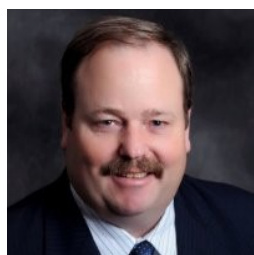
It was a busy place with lots of people present to bring awareness to these very important supports for the disability community. AccessAbility was proud to participate.
