In summer, it provides power washing of parking garages, mobile fleet washing for companies like Fed Ex and Lund's, power washing and staining of decks, fences, and other wood surfaces, washing of asphalt roofs and houses. They provide Christmas lighting installation services for businesses and homes and snow removal services in the winter. Roof-to-Deck has placed a number of graduates of our Project Connect program in both full-time and part-time jobs as technicians in the deck and exterior wood restoration business and the mobile fleet and parking lot washing business segments.

So moved by the work of AccessAbility, Mike Hilborn became a member of the Board of Directors in 2020. He has commented that "AAI's internal businesses are very impressive. Running a business inside a business that helps people get employment is very surprising." Mike feels the staff works very hard to do great work as proven by the longevity of many of the staff. 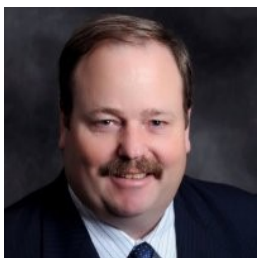
